



Middle School Uniform Policy

Uniform Requirements



Shirts - BelovED Community Charter School red polo shirt with the school's logo. The shirt is available in short and long sleeves. Shirts must be worn tucked in.

Pants - Standard khaki-colored or tan pants.

Skirts - Standard khaki-colored or tan skirts. Skirts must be no more than two inches above the knee.

Shoes - Rubber sole sneakers/tennis shoes. Shoes must be flat and closed-toe. **No Crocs are permitted.**

Sweater (Optional) - BelovED Community Charter School navy sweater with or without the school's logo. **Sweaters must be solid navy blue with no hood.**

Optional Professional Dress



Shirts - Light blue button-up shirt with school logo. The shirt is available in short or long sleeves. Shirt must be worn with a red and navy blue striped tie. Shirts must be worn tucked in.

Pants - Standard khaki-colored or tan pants or shorts. The pants need to fit correctly (no baggy style).

Skirts - Standard khaki-colored or tan skirts. Shorts and skirts must be no more than two inches above the knee.

Ties: A navy blue, white, or red tie. Striped ties in any combination of these colors are allowed. No other colors or patterns are permitted.

Shoes - Rubber sole sneakers/tennis shoes. Shoes must be flat and closed-toe. **No high heels or Crocs are permitted.**

Blazer/Sweater - BelovED Community Charter School navy blazer, navy cardigan sweater, navy sweater vest with or without the school's logo. **Blazers/Sweaters must be solid navy blue with no hood.**



PE Uniform

Scholars will wear PE uniforms on physical education days. The PE uniform shall consist of:



- T-shirt** - must be red with the school's logo
- Shorts** - Navy blue mid-thigh to knee length
- Sweatpants** - Navy blue only
- Sweatshirt** - Navy blue zip-up/hooded sweatshirt with the BelovED logo. Any BelovED athletic hoodie purchased through the school is also acceptable.
- Shoes** - Rubber sole sneakers/tennis shoes (Scholars not wearing sneakers on a PE day will be asked to sit out of class for safety reasons.)

Dress Down Days

On occasion scholars are permitted to have out of uniform days ("Dress Down Days"), but must be dressed neatly and in a manner that is appropriate for school. No ripped or torn jeans and cropped or halter shirts may be worn. Furthermore, any clothing that denotes gang affiliations or has messaging containing drugs or curses is inappropriate for a school setting. Any scholars violating this dress code will be provided loaner uniform clothes to wear and will have DeansList points deducted.

Dress Down Days are not at the discretion of scholars, but will be announced by a school administrator. Scholars may dress down on their birthday, but must obtain a pass from the Dean.
