1. Update re. George L. Gonzalez Civil Action.

VII. Board Comments

- 1. Latest update on HIB provided by the Head Dean, 2 (two) submitted, and none met the specific criteria to be qualified as HIB. Reports submitted to date are currently about half of what they were at this time last school year. Discussed how the term "Bullying" is used freely at this time. Briefly discussed the specific criteria of what bullying is and the span of time (i.e., over a specified period of time) that needs to be met in order qualify as a bullying.
- 2. Discussion on how the administration handles those scholars who are facing emotional distress. Focusing on the following areas: On-call counselors, reach out to Jersey City Medical Center, safety team, bring in resources (i.e., other social organizations), county level provided support under the state superintendent, child study teams, IEP's, 504's.
- 3. Head Dean recently attended a district wide Special Education meeting. Discussion included bringing in a Specialist in to talk with parents, as well as pull out in working groups.
- 4. Board of Trustees, Treasurer indicated the need for a clear cut delineation of duties outlined for Head Dean, Principal and Middle School Dean. Identify decision making, policies, procedures and how each is carried through.
- 5. Head Dean discussed the current Bereavement Policy. Clarifying the oddities and wanting further clarification on what family member/household member is identified under Bereavement time and number of times an employee can use it each school year.
- 6. Director of Operations provided an update on the bus parking lot. Lights and fence are seventy five (75) percent complete. The replacement of the gate, then side walk/landscaping work are to follow. Looking to be complete by early March.
- 7. School Consultant discussed the Modular Annex drawing, followed by the current tree ordinance. Along with the type of materials (i.e., hardy board) used in the classrooms.

- 8. A Planning Board is scheduled for the following Tuesday which the School Consultant will be in attendance. It will consist of a Section 31 review to fulfill the responsibility as a fellow government entity the provide the courtesy to inform as to what BelovED is planning regarding permits and construction.
- 9. School Consultant provided update on the planned removal of the trailer classroom/ Planned to occur the 3rd week of April. The pouring of the foundation will immediately follow. The 3rd week of June, the Modular Annex will be placed onto the concrete footings. July, the work will begin inside the Modular Annex.
- 10. Discussed the new layout of the playground, along with the roofing expansion relating to the Multi-Purpose Room expansion and the improvements to the landscaping around the building all to occur in the summer.
- 11. Director of Operations created a draft of a Transportation Employee Handbook to be incorporated into the Transportation policies within BelovED Community Charter School.
- 12. Discussed the development of the school at 525 Grand Street. Work to begin April 1, starting with the relocation of existing sewer lines. June install of the piles. Total cost for the 19,000 square foot building to be \$3.6 million dollars, which is coming in lower than the original estimated cost of \$4.0 million dollars. Building will house a full size gymnasium.
- 13. Updated on the recent deposition regarding the re. George Gonzalez Civil Action case. Four out of five individuals were deposed. The civil litigation of the case will be placed on hold till the March timeframe until the criminal case moves forward first (i.e., jitney driver who drove with a suspended license is facing criminal charges).
- 14. Discussed recent breakfast meeting held with the Jersey City Board of Education President, BelovED's School Consultant and the Mayor of Jersey City to discuss its stance on the moratorium of Jersey City Charter Schools.
- 15. Motion (for the March Agenda) was made by Sal Salvatore and seconded by Sheridan Bell to add a resolution to give signature authority on BelovED's operating bank account to Nicole Jackson.
- 16. Discussed the Conrail land and upkeep. Conrail currently sends their own crew to mow, clear and clean up property twice per year. The Board of Trustees made the recommendation to ask Conrail if cleanup can requested for more than twice a year. Area is identified to be an eye sore to the school. It was also identified that it would likely be a liability to have a neighborhood cleanup,
